



## Is a great way to help Epsilon Sigma's alumni, Legion of 100 & the international fraternity!

### Epsilon Sigma Alumni Association

- Helps chapter alums stay in touch with each other and informed about their fraters and fraternity.
- This year we'll again host homecoming, several lunch get togethers across the state, continue to ID chapter members who served in the military to add their names to the new chapter Military Recognition Plaque and present them a service recognition certificate. We'll continue to update and maintain the alum member contact info. list and we'll produce at least two electronic newsletters. When asked and if possible, we also assist the undergraduate chapter
- Just paid the \$200 biennial alumni association fee to charter our alumni assn. another 2 years, and again sent an alum delegate to conclave. We'll do the same next year.
- Alumni Association Dues are minimum \$35 per year, and the average dues volunteered by each frater are around \$45 a year.

### Epsilon Sigma Legion of 100

- Composed of chapter fraters helping the chapter by donating \$5 or more a month (the average monthly donation by Legion participants is just over \$20 per month)
- Helps the chapter make one-time necessary or advantageous purchases that otherwise would not be possible from chapter dues. Also allows undergrads to attend key educational or leadership conferences and programs.
- Undergraduates now must pay almost \$80 per month dues. Most of this goes for mandated international fraternity fees for annual membership dues, insurance, conclave delegate, and other items. This leaves very little to cover chapter operations, social and rush expenses. And, \$80 a month is a lot for young college students to pay, on top of several hundred dollars for covenant (pledging) and initiation fees, special assessments, and other out-of-pocket expenses to belong to the chapter.

### Life Loyal Teke (LLT)

- This program is operated by the international fraternity to engage and inform alums and raise additional funds to operate the fraternity's program and services. LLT's receive a handsome certificate, pin and card.
- Minimum to be part of Life Loyal Teke is \$18,99 per year.

\* Donations to the 18.99 "Knights" Legion of 100 program or at any other Legion of 100 level may be made monthly through an ACH withdrawal or paid annually

To participate in each of these programs at the average participation level  
is around \$304/year, or \$25.33 per month **BUT...**
