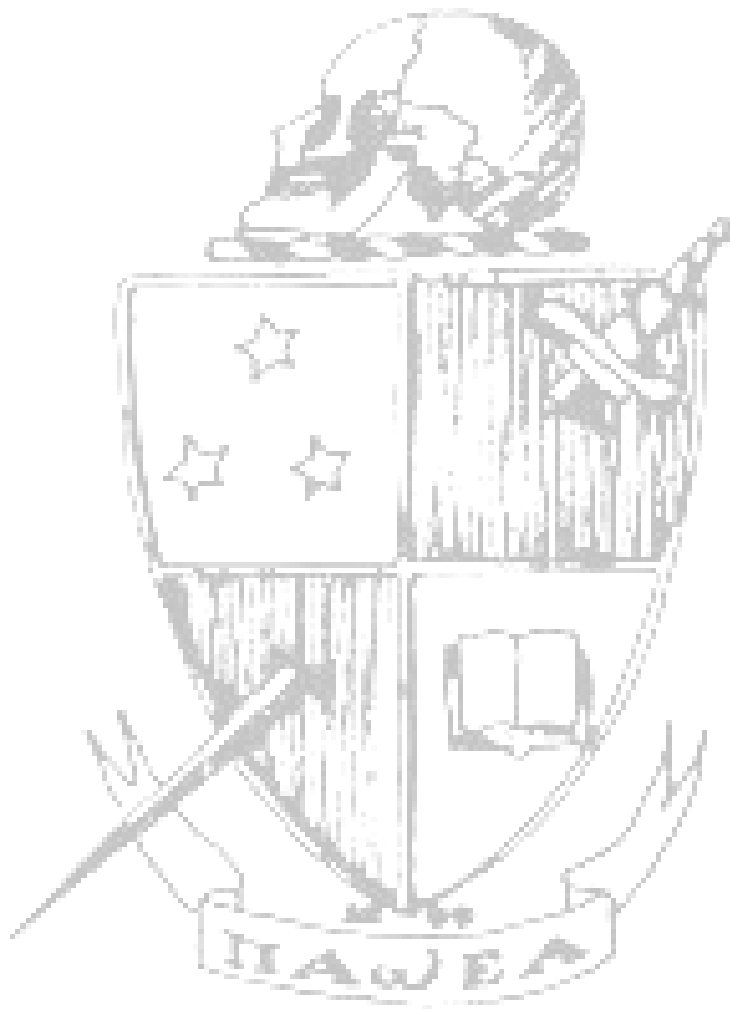

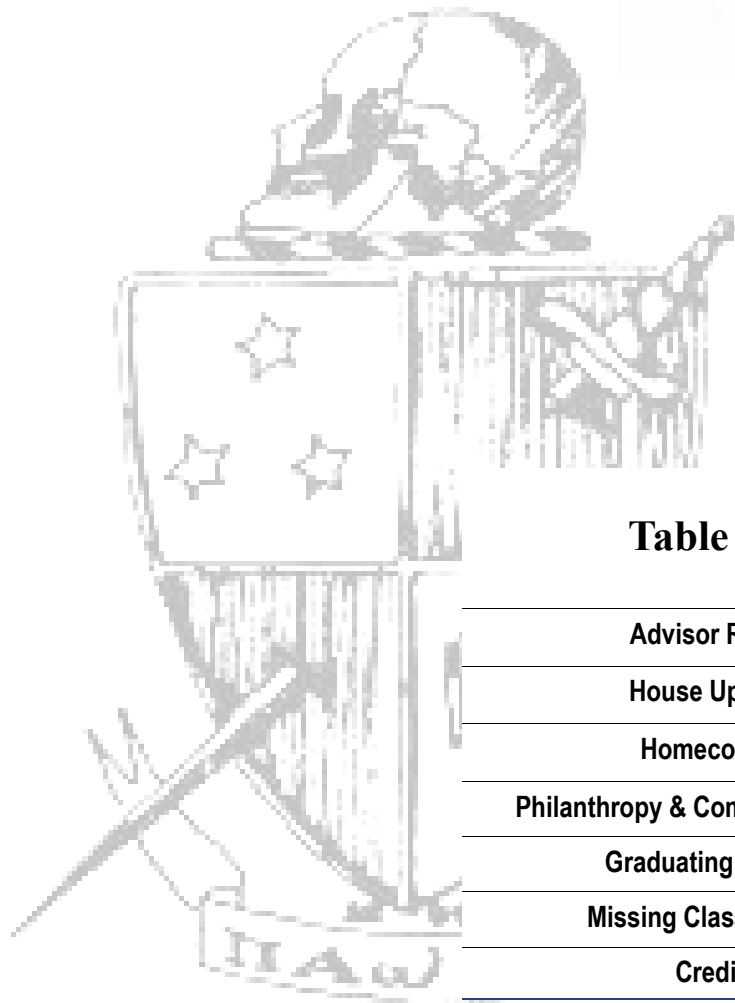
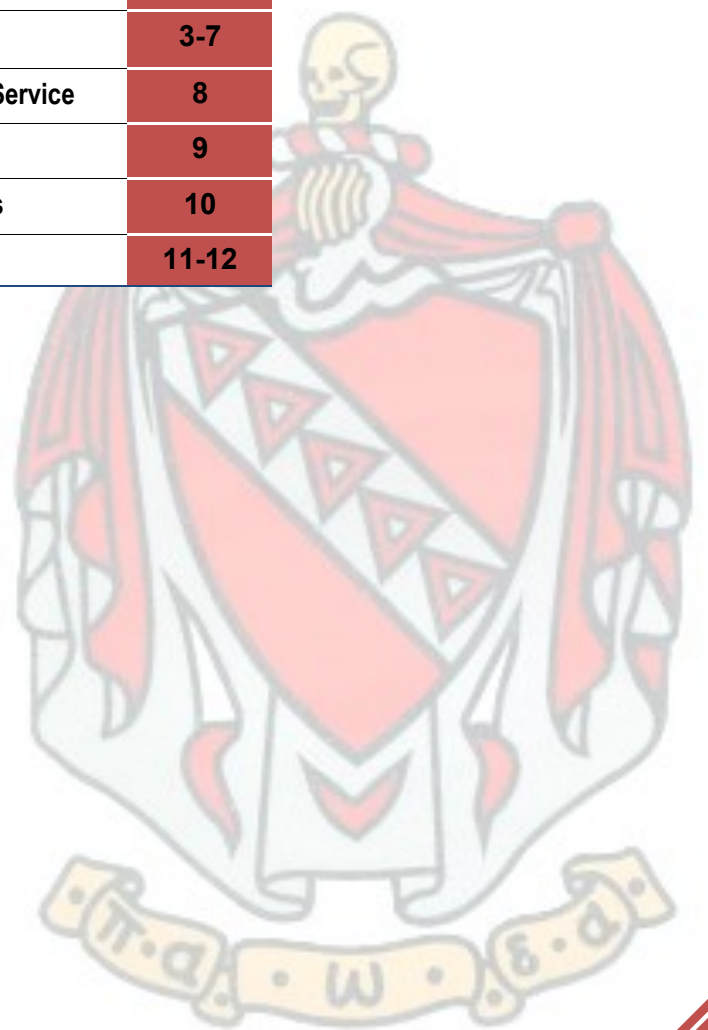

Thoughts from the Chapter Advisor

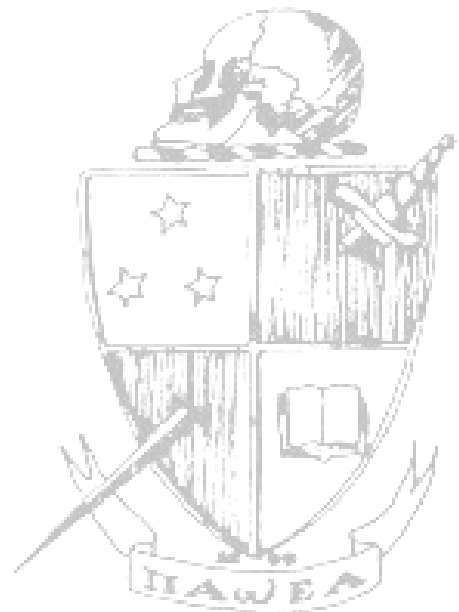

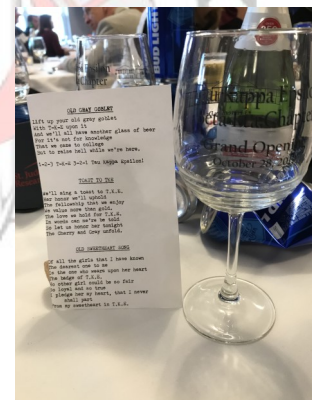
