KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of Missouri, relating to benevolent, religious, scientific, educational and miscellaneous associations under Article Ten, Chapter 33, of the Revised Statutes, 1939, in connection with others, have entered into the following agreement:

First: The name of this association shall be MISSOURI SCHOOL OF MINES TEKE, INCORPORATED.

Second: Its location shall be in Rolla, Phelps County, Missouri.

Third: Its duration shall be perpetual.

Fourth: This association is formed for the following purposes: to promote temperance, literary, historical, and scientific study of its members, and of the community; to promote the welfare, culture, and education of college students by acquiring and operating housing for such students on a non-profit basis; and to promote Christian ideals and loyalty to American democratic institutions. In order to effectuate the aforementioned purposes, the corporation may acquire, lease, hold, operate, convey and mortgage real and personal property, and may issue notes, bonds, and other evidences of indebtedness, all to the extent permitted by law and without profit.

PRO FORMA DECREE OF INCORPORATION

And now, on this day come Smith Caddy, as president, Paul E. Evans, as vice-president, Dr. John W. B. Hill, as secretary, and D. W. Mitchell, as treasurer of Missouri School of Mines Teke, incorporated, and submit to the court the articles of agreement of said association, together with a petition praying for a pro forma decree thereon, in the manner provided by law, and it appearing to the court that said petition has remained on file in the clerk's office of this court for at least three days since the same was first presented to the court, and the court having duly examined said articles of agreement, and being duly advised in the premises, doth now consider, adjudge and determine that said articles of agreement, and the purposes of the association as therein expressed, come properly within the purview of Article Ten, Chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Missouri, 1939, and are not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of the State of Missouri.

Therefore, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the petitioners and their associates named in said articles of agreement be and are hereby treated a body politic and corporate entity under the corporate name of Missouri School of Mines Teke, Incorporated.
